

Online Support for Unpaid Carers in Derbyshire

Derbyshire County Council is piloting a new service to reach out online to Carers in the area. The pilot project with **Mobilise**, which started in January, will use social media and digital marketing to help find and identify 'unpaid Carers', connecting them immediately with others in a similar position, and providing relevant, timely support.
